

Eugene DePasquale is serving his second term as Pennsylvania's 51st Auditor General. Previously, he served in Pennsylvania's House of Representatives in the 95th district and as Deputy Secretary for the state's Department of Environmental Protection.

Eugene grew up in a working-class family in Pittsburgh where he played baseball and football, and worked in his parents' neighborhood bar. Eugene's youngest brother was diagnosed with Muscular Dystrophy and passed away after a long battle. Because of his brother's "pre-existing condition" Eugene's family was unable to get health insurance to help with the costs of medical care. That's why protecting coverage for pre-existing conditions and affordable medicine are so personal to him.

As a state representative, Eugene challenged the status quo and demanded more government accountability and transparency. He became Pennsylvania's first public official to publicly post all of his expenses online.

As Auditor General, Eugene is taking on entrenched bureaucrats, special interests, and fraudsters. He's helped protect children from abuse, demanded thousands of untested rape kits be processed, exposed abuse in nursing homes, and taken steps to combat the climate crisis. Eugene's audits have saved taxpayers over \$1 billion by exposing government waste, fraud and abuse.

Now Eugene is running for Congress to fight for people in Pennsylvania's 10th Congressional District.
